6. New conclusions of the thesis:

Firstly, academic and theoretical contributions:

The thesis is the first scientific work in Vietnam to systematically and comprehensively study the issue of privacy protection in television newspaper products. On the basis of synthesizing and analyzing theoretical and practical documents, the thesis has developed the concept of "privacy in television newspaper products", and at the same time clarified the connotation of this concept in relation to close concepts such as "private life", "personal information", etc "information security"...

The thesis applies and combines a number of modern theoretical frameworks, including: Privacy Control Theory, Communication Privacy Management, Framing Theory, and Social Responsibility Theory. thereby forming an integrated theoretical framework to analyze the protection of privacy in television press products.

Secondly, practical contributions:

The thesis has conducted a survey and analyzed the current situation of privacy protection in three typical news TV programs, namely 24-hour Motion (VTV1), 24-hour Security (ANTV), and 18:30 News (HTV1). Through a combination of qualitative and quantitative surveys, case studies and in-depth interviews, the thesis has shown ways to protect privacy on television, thereby systematizing the elements, requirements, scope, and methods in the production process of television newspaper products to protect privacy.

Third, new theses:

Clearly identify the groups of information that fall under the privacy rights that need to be protected on television, from basic information to sensitive information and personal life. In addition, the thesis also determines the object of protection and the level of privacy protection.

Analyze factors that affect the extent of privacy breaches or protections in practice.

Clarifying the relationship between journalistic ethics and privacy, thereby affirming that protecting privacy is not only a legal obligation but also an ethical standard of journalism.

Fourth, recommendations and applications:

From the theoretical analysis and practical survey results, the thesis has proposed a system of feasible and high-value solutions to improve the effectiveness of privacy protection in television press products in Vietnam.

In particular, the thesis has proposed to develop a set of guidelines for privacy protection specifically for television press activities, contributing to the improvement of professional regulations in the context of modern media. These proposals are not only meaningful for press agencies but also a basis for training institutions, management agencies and professional organizations to refer to in policy making and professional training.
