7. New Contributions of the Dissertation:

First, the dissertation expands the traditional research direction by placing “credibility” - a long-standing moral value - within the modern context of administrative reform, the socialist-oriented market economy, international integration, and social media. This approach provides a new perspective on credibility, not only within the realm of personal morality or Confucian tradition, but also within the domains of public service, governance, and contemporary social interaction.

Second, the study integrates the subjects, content, and methods of building credibility-from officials, organizations, and inspection-supervision systems to the participation of the people and society. This represents an advancement compared with previous studies, which mainly focused on theoretical or individual behavioral aspects, without comprehensively analyzing the operational mechanisms and interrelations among various actors.

Third, the dissertation proposes practical and multidimensional solutions to enhance credibility - not only from the perspective of officials but also from that of the Party, the State, the people, social organizations, and each individual. This is a new contribution because it emphasizes that building credibility is a comprehensive process that requires the synchronized participation of all forces, closely associated with effective public service, the strengthening of political trust, and the enhancement of the prestige of the political system.
